TERRITORIAL DEVELOPMENT

Through our **Territorial Development line,** we lead high-impact projects that contribute towards social, urban and economic development for the families of the Caribbean region and towards strengthening the region's institutions.

MEGAPROJECTS

Together with the Ministry of Housing, local mayor's offices and multiple allies, we articulate urban, social and economic development in the two low-income housing Megaprojects in the Caribbean region, **Bicentenario in Cartagena**, and **Villas de San Pablo in Barranquilla**, to provide the population access to better opportunities and enable them to develop their life projects.

While in a traditional housing development, access to housing is the end goal, in the Megaprojects it is about access to better opportunities for local families.



Bicentenario in Cartagena

We contribute towards reducing the housing deficit in Cartagena and Barranquilla by offering a comprehensive housing solution, and a **15-minute city model** for **more than 300,000 people** to enable them to develop their life projects.

We developed a clothing manufacturing workshop in Bicentenario and a Contact Center in Villas de San Pablo to allow the local population access to jobs close to their homes and boost the economy of the Megaprojects.

URBAN

The Fundación Santo Domingo contributes towards reducing the housing deficit in Barranquilla and Cartagena, and towards creating a vision for Integral Urban Development in the country, through the development of macro-projects that improve the well-being of the population (integral vision) and through urban interventions in selected territories.





Project based on Urban Acupuncture, which refers to the intervention of strategic places in the territories through landscaping, lighting, road signs, graphic urban art, educational activities and tourism and entrepreneurship projects, in order to promote peaceful coexistence, proper use of public space and the socioeconomic reactivation. 19,970 square meters intervened.







11,316 square meters intervened in public squares and parks. **576 square** meters of inclusive ramps.
